With all new content and conversations planned, the 2024 AOA SGRC Regional Advocacy Meetings will build on the foundational elements of 2023 meetings and dive deeper into specific tactics used by optometry advocates to navigate the legislative landscape successfully. Hear from those advocates who have found success with several issues affecting our profession.
